

## ***Post Graduate Diploma in Midwifery Commencing 31 January 2010***

Albury Wodonga Health (AWH) Wodonga Campus (WC) has positions available for Registered Nurses interested in completing their Graduate Diploma in Midwifery.

- 12 month program, two intakes annually of up to 6 students each.
- Provided externally through Charles Sturt University (CSU), Wagga Campus. CSU offer Commonwealth Supported Places.
- Students are employed part time (four days per week) whilst studying.
- Wodonga Campus offers 2 scholarships annually to the value of \$2500 each.
- Paid study leave to attend mandatory residential school.
- Dedicated Midwifery Student Midwife Educator and Clinical Support nurse.
- Nine weeks paid supernumerary time to enable the student to fulfil the clinical requirements.
- Salary and conditions in accordance with the Nurses (Victorian Public Health Sector) Multiple Business agreement 2007-2011)

- Current CV which includes 3 current acute nursing referees.

- Successful applicants are required to pass all elements of the course in order to remain within the program.
