

BECOMING A RANZCP TRAINEE IN NSW IN 2019

All potential first year trainees must follow the two-step application process outlined below:

2. **NSW Health Junior Medical Officer (JMO) Recruitment (Trainee Positions).**

Please note you must apply to both RANZCP and NSW Health. These are both essential and separate processes.
